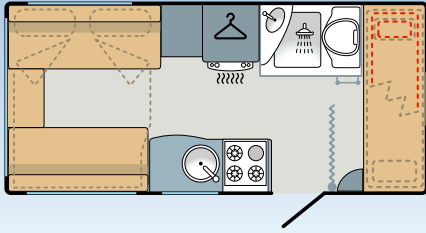
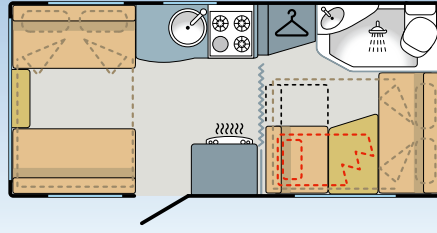

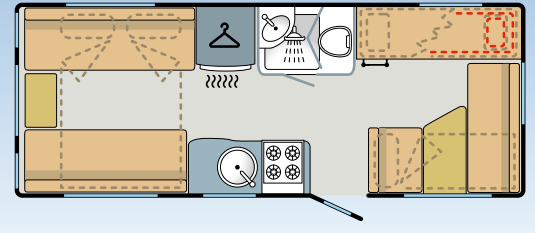

Sprite ideas!

SPRITE HAS BEEN revamped for 2010 with three new models arriving. The Musketeer name returns with the triple-bunk, five-berth EB and the five-berth TD. The TD has a nearside rear dinette that turns into a double bed, with a fold-out bunk above and an offside corner washroom.

The other new arrival is actually a rethinking of the Major 6. Gone is the side-dinette bunk layout, in favour of fixed triple bunks and a nearside corner dinette.

The two Musketeers replace the twin-dinette Major 5 and twin-axle Quattro ES, leaving the fixed-bed Quattro FB as the only twin-axle Sprite.

Sprites have always been lightweight, affordable tourers, which will not change next season, despite an increase in kit. Among other

things the 2010 Sprites get a big 107-litre Thetford fridge, GRP sink and drop-down doors on the bed boxes. Kitchen equipment includes the new Thetford oven and separate grill and a three-burner hob with spark ignition.

Prices have yet to be announced but they will include an Al-Ko stabiliser, spare wheel and carrier, entrance-door flyscreen and scatter cushions. The Diamond Pack remains a cost option and now includes alloy wheels and Al-Ko Secure receivers.

New woodgrain-effect worktops, flat-fronted lockers, a digital control panel and new graphics give the new Sprites a great contemporary look.
